

Birmingham



By rail

Birmingham City Centre is served by New Street Station, Moor Street Station and Snow Hill Station. It is only a short taxi ride to Three Brindleyplace.

If you would prefer to walk, Brindleyplace is 15 minutes from New Street Station. Follow the signs for the International Convention Centre (ICC). This route takes you through Victoria Square, Chamberlain Square, under the library and across Centenary Square. Walk through the ICC and cross the canal. Continue past Café Rouge into Central Square. Three Brindleyplace is the brick colonnaded building on the right.

By air

From the airport, take the bus link to Birmingham International railway station where you can catch a train to Birmingham New Street. Alternatively, take a taxi direct to the office. This journey may take about 40 minutes. The pedestrian entrance to the building faces on to the square. Towers Watson is on the fifth floor.

Birmingham

By road

From M6 (North and South)

Leave the M6 at Junction 6 and follow signs for A38M Birmingham Central. Stay on the A38M in the second lane for approximately three miles following signs for Birmingham City Centre. Pass over the flyover at Lancaster Circus (Aston University is on the left.) Keep in the left-hand lane signposted Bromsgrove A36. Proceed through St Chads Queensway tunnel. Emerging from the tunnel immediately bear off to the left, signposted 'Convention P'.

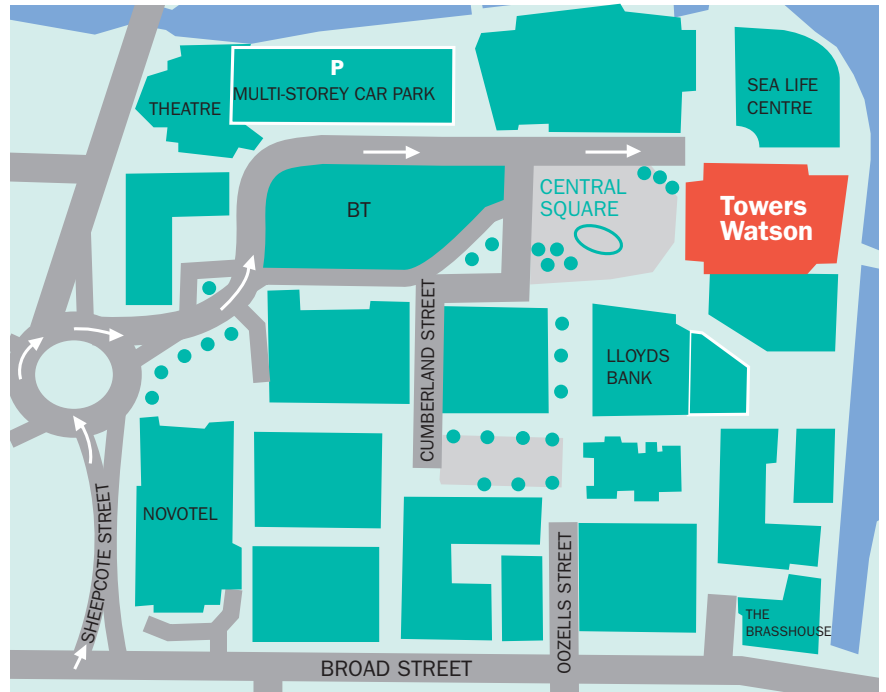
Stay on Great Charles Street Queensway to Paradise Circus and take the second exit onto Broad Street. The International Convention Centre is on the right and the Hyatt Hotel is on the left. Continue straight on for a quarter of a mile. At the set of traffic lights adjacent to the Novotel, turn right into Sheepcote Street. Turn right at the first roundabout. Bear left past the Mint Hotel and the multi-storey car park, Three Brindleyplace is facing you on the opposite side of Central Square.

From M5 (North and South)

Leave the M5 at Junction 3. At the motorway island, follow signs for Birmingham City Centre (A456). Keep on the A456 (Hagley Road West) for approximately two miles. At the first set of traffic lights (at the junction of the A4123) carry straight on following signs for Birmingham City Centre (A456).

Carry straight on over a second set of traffic lights. Hagley Road West becomes Hagley Road as you enter Edgbaston. After a further two and a half miles, approaching Five Ways, keep in the right hand lane, take the right exit lane and proceed under the island.

Move into the left-hand lane and at the next set of traffic lights, just before you reach the Novotel, turn left into Sheepcote Street. Turn right at the first roundabout into Brindleyplace. bear left past the Mint Hotel and the multi-storey car park. Three Brindleyplace is facing you on the opposite side of Central Square.



Drive across the square and then down the slope, with the Sea Life Centre on your left and Three Brindleyplace on your right. The entrance to the basement car park is on the right at the bottom – ring the bell to contact building reception to gain entrance. Towers Watson is on the fifth floor.
