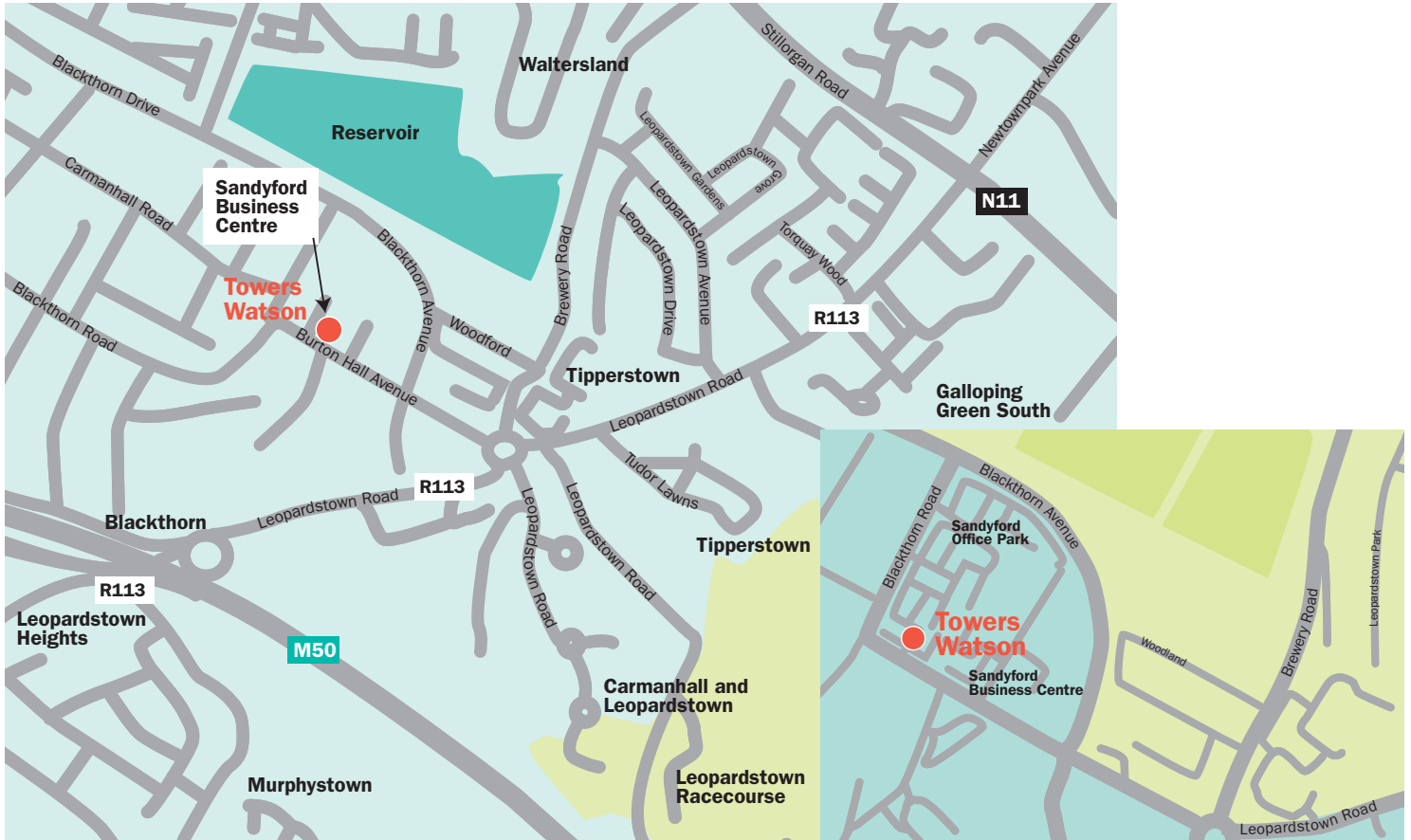

By Luas from Dublin City Centre to Sandyford

Take the Green Luas Line from St Stephens Green to Sandyford. Towers Watson is a five minute walk from here along Blackthorn Road.

By Bus from Heuston Station to Sandyford

Iarnrod Eireann operates a regular shuttle service to the central bus station in the city centre.

From there it is a five minute walk across Butt Bridge turning right up Burgh Quay and left onto Hawkins Street where you can get the 44C bus to Sandyford getting off at Corrig Road.

Or from the bus station walk under the railway bridge with the Customs House on your left and up Abbey Street to O'Connell Street and take the No. 5 or 11/11A bus getting off at Carmanhall Road. Or get the No. 145 bus from Heuston Station to St Stephens Green and take the green Luas Line to Sandyford.

By Dart from Dublin City Centre to Sandyford

From the Bus Station across Butt Bridge turn left to Tara Street Station. (Entrance under Railway Bridge)

and taking the south bound train to Blackrock. There is a bus station right outside the Dart Station; there you can get the 114, 115 or 17 bus to Sandyford getting off at Blackthorn Avenue, just outside Woodies.

From the Ferry Port at Dun Laoghaire to Sandyford

Take a taxi directly to Towers Watson approximately 15 minutes journey.

From Dublin Airport to Sandyford

Take a taxi directly to Towers Watson approximately a 45 minute journey (€45) or Aircoach (€8) www.aircoach.ie/dublin.airport.transport.timetables.php Blue bus that stops outside the arrivals hall and goes directly to Sandyford.

Or get the No. 16 bus from the arrivals hall to St Stephen's green and the Green Luas Line to Sandyford (€5)

From Mount Street to Sandyford

The No. 47 bus goes via Mount Street to the Industrial Estate. The stop is on Blackthorn Avenue.
